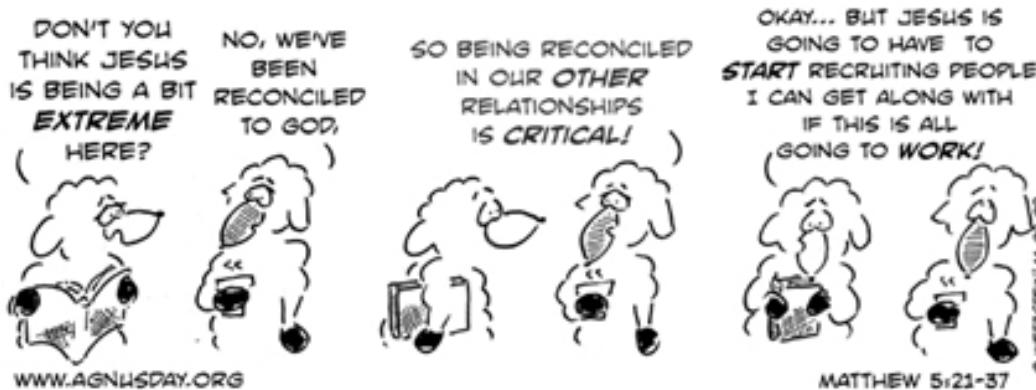
READING
