BELLS TOLL FROM OUR THREE CATHEDRALS TO MARK YORKSHIRE'S DARKEST DAY OF FIRST WORLD WAR

A single bell will toll from each of the three cathedrals of Bradford, Ripon and Wakefield at the exact time one hundred years ago, on Friday 1st July, that the first troops went over the top at the start of the Battle of the Somme. People from across the region are invited to come and remember that darkest day in silence and prayers to remember all those who lost their lives in what was to be the bloodiest battles of the First World War.

Bradford Cathedral - Bradford lost almost 2,000 men in the Battle of the Somme and will hold its own civic commemoration in the Cathedral on Saturday July 9 at 3pm
