- We hope you will join us for refreshments after the service

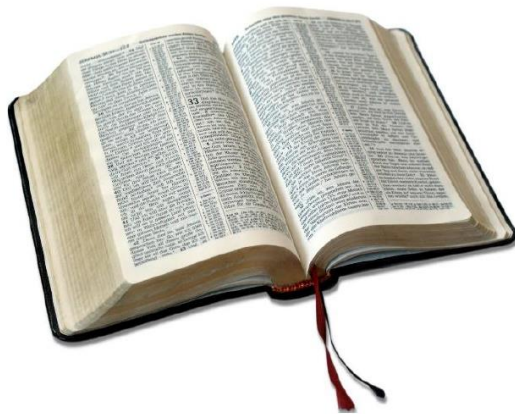
