The Children's Society

The Children's Society is a national charity working to transform the hopes and happiness of young people facing abuse, exploitation and neglect. It supports them through their most serious life challenges and campaigns tirelessly for the rights of young people in dreadful situations, working for social changes that will improve the lives of those who need hope most.

They've been doing this for 140 years - their role has changed and developed (at one time they were the Church of England Children's Society and were an adoption agency among other things). Their vision is, together with young people and supporters, to create a place where hope is alive in every child; to build a happier, safer society for young people to grow up in, one where they can look forward to their futures, instead of living in fear, often ignored and uncared for, or sometimes, much worse.

As well as working directly with young people, the Children's Society develops resources and delivers training to other professionals who work with children - from young carers to those at risk of being exploited, abused, and neglected.

So it's that time of year again! It's the time when we bring our Children's Society boxes to church to be emptied. But....so many of us, don't use cash in the same way that we did, and therefore can't watch our boxes fill up with spare change. I know some people still put their £1(50p, 20p) coin in the box every week, but others, post-Covid, rarely have change.

So on behalf of all the young people who are neglected, exploited and abused, can I ask you either to bring your box to Church and leave it for Debbie Child to empty; or if your box is empty and you'd prefer to donate, just give that to Debbie or leave in an envelope with a churchwarden.
